

**ORDINANCE 2009 – 02**

**CITY OF DUNDAS  
STATE OF MINNESOTA**

*An Interim Ordinance to Protect the Planning Process  
While Conducting Studies to Consider Adoption of  
Regulations for Annexation Area*

**WHEREAS**, Minnesota Statutes 462.355, Subd 4, allows a municipality that is conducting studies for the purpose of considering adoption or amendment of an official control to adopt an interim ordinance for the purpose of protecting the planning process and the health, safety and welfare of its citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Dundas desires to protect the planning process as defined in MN Statutes Chapter 462.355 and provide for a reasonable opportunity to study and hold hearings regarding adoption of zoning regulations for the annexation area described in the Joint Orderly Annexation Agreement between the City of Dundas and Bridgewater Township

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the City of Dundas ordains:

1. The Annexation Reserve District Ordinance (Draft of 9/02/2009) is adopted as an interim zoning ordinance for the annexation area.
2. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and shall remain in effect until March 1, 2010, unless extended by agreement of the City Council and Town Board.
