CANNON VALLEY DISC GOLF

The group presented their new concept which would locate the disc golf course just to the north of the new dog park in the Regional Park. They asked staff to send the group the layout of the dog park that shows the future expansion area and to ask the disc golf group to re-design the layout in that now smaller area – or pivot back to the park/open space next to the Stoneridge development. Further, they asked staff to contact the City Attorney about an agreement between the group and the City for use of that space and equipment for disc golf.
